
Dear Mr. Rickard:

This is in reference to the notice of public hearing on the subject development scheduled for July 20, 1992. The EIR indicates that the Ventura County Flood Control District (VCFCD) is willing to maintain proposed pumps and the detention basin. VCFCD has not and will not agree to the proposed maintenance of the detention basin and has not reviewed its adequacy.

We have been working with city staff and consultants on the on-and-off ramps at Borchard and Highway 101, which would cross South Branch Arroyo Conejo, to find a solution to the drainage problem in the area. We feel we are close to a solution that would eliminate the need for the detention basin on this project site. Consideration should be given to requiring this developer to contribute to the solution which will free up the land proposed for the detention basin.
